- Very good and shows you are considering all options; even if it comes back with 'nothing is changing', then at least it shows there has been the discussion.





#### **Current Recreational Use**


The most popular past times currently undertaken around the Island's reservoirs are those **on foot** such as **walking**, **running** and **orienteering**.



**9.6%** of responders said they did not currently undertake a recreational past time on or around the Island's reservoirs.




#### **Current Recreational Use Data**





## **Water & Non-water Supply Reservoirs**




Desired recreational requirements are similar for water supply and non-water supply reservoirs






## **Desired Recreational Use for Water Supply Reservoirs**










## **Desired Recreational Use for Non-water supply Reservoirs**

These priorities were comparable for both water supply and non-water supply reservoirs






## Public Opinion of Who should Control Recreational Use






## **Public Opinion of How to Fund Recreational Use (1)**






## **Public Opinion of How to Fund Recreational Use (2)**

## **Suggested Considerations (1)**

#### **Fire and Rescue Service**

- Requirement to undertake Risk Assessments
- Enhanced Signage



- Telecommunication coverage checks with emergency alternatives
- Liaison with the Emergency Services and on-site training opportunities
- 'In, On, or Near Water' training/education programmes/information



## **Suggested Considerations (2)**

#### **DEFA Interests**

- Fisheries: Fully support continued recreational use on reservoirs and would be willing to contribute resource towards improvements to angling opportunities on reservoirs.
- **Biodiversity:** Continued liaison with DEFA on all aspects of management is welcome and provided that works are carried out within the scope of the Wildlife Act, DEFA will support the Authority.
- Access & Recreation: The Forestry Amenity and Lands Directorate supports the Authority's plans. The Directorate will be happy to provide further advice based on what it learned from the development of recreation on the Forestry estate and looks forward to taking advantage of joint working opportunities.



## **Suggested Considerations (3)**

#### **Rushen Parish Commissioners**

If there were to be organised activities then there should be a charge, but only if the collection of those charges did not outweigh the income obtained from them.

#### **Discover Diving Club**

Diving on inland sites is very appealing, but not without its hazards. We suggest licensing, similar to that for fishing, and Bye-Laws to make certain activities illegal. Cost for the Authority would be limited and revenue gained through permit fees.



#### **Comments (1)**

"The leisure use of the reservoirs is really as much a matter for DCCL & DED tourism to consider as for WSA."

"Restrictions are one thing, but ensuring compliance by monitoring and enforcing must be part of the package. If the aim is to protect our health by having restrictions, they must be enforced."

"I'm all for access, but in such a sensitive area there has to be a degree of control which should be paid for by those using the areas. Water must not be contaminated by animal faecal matter or litter."



#### **Comments (2)**

Compromise is clearly needed; only the largest of our reservoirs having the capacity, for example to support sailing simultaneously with kayaking and possibly fishing.

Each reservoir will need examining on its merits and it may well turn out that some are not adequate for anything more than the present fishing possibilities they afford



#### Comments (3)

"The possible need to charge for the use would be dependent on the activity. I think if you don't enter the water/on the water then you shouldn't have to pay but if you get onto or in the water then you will need to pay. Also the question then is who will enforce/regulate this?"

"Any activity that requires infrastructure changes should be funded by the club or organisation concerned and should be subject to approval by the WSA/Govt and any planning details should be approved by the appropriate Government Department."

"If access was regulated by registered clubs, using a permit scheme, then it might be better to charge for a permit, which allows the club access to the reservoir for a stated amount of time. i.e. a weekend. Similar to the DOI's scheme for access to old quarries for recreational activities."



## **Conclusions Drawn (1)**

- The most popular activities currently undertaken in the reservoir areas are those on foot (e.g. walking, running etc).
- The most popular desired activities are also those on foot.
- These activities are commonly undertaken by individuals and not through recreational clubs.
- There is very little difference in preference of activity around the water supply versus the non-water supply reservoirs.
- There are clear conflicts in attitude between the different recreational groups.
- There are also clear public concerns regarding compliance and enforcement.



## **Conclusions Drawn (2)**

- The priority desired facilities are: litter bins, life saving equipment, dog waste bins, information boards and parking.
- The majority of respondents indicated that the Water and Sewerage Authority should control recreational use on reservoir lands.
- The majority of respondents indicated that recreational use on reservoir lands should be Government funded.
- When asked the question about payment to access recreational facilities, only 23% stated that they would definitely not consider it. Many of those who indicated that they would consider a payment stated that it would depend on the activity and facilities on offer.




## **Problems** Associated with Recreational Use (1)

#### **The Bottom Line**

- Human activity on or around a reservoir, used to supply drinking water to the community, is considered to be a potential source of contamination; impacts of risks must be carefully considered.
- The structural integrity of the reservoirs is a top priority and must not be compromised. Some of the areas in and around the reservoirs are not designed for, and are not sufficiently resilient, to sustain recreational use.
- WSA have a duty to protect aquatic and associated ecosystems by reducing and preventing pollution and degradation of local water resources.

## How Do Other Water Supply Companies Approach Recreational Use?



#### **Guernsey Water**

- 3KM long nature trial created
- Maintained by Environment Guernsey
- Two wardens take care of the site and ensure it is being used sympathetically by keeping the paths clear of vegetation and litter and minimising disturbance to the wildlife
- They also regularly report to Guernsey Water on how rainfall and storage levels are affecting plant and animal life
- Walkers are asked to keep to the footpath and keep dogs on leads
- Only fishermen are permitted to use the various access points to the water's edge and fishing is only allowed by members of the Guernsey Trout Society





#### **Jersey**



- Fishing is only permitted to members in certain locations
- Dogs must be kept on a lead, not allowed to enter water and fouling must be cleaned up



- x Litter: no bins on site
- X No swimming
- X No toilet facilities or designated parking
- x Wildlife must not be fed
- x Cycling not permitted
- x No disabled access





#### **Yorkshire Water**

- Free reservoir walk and running routes, including maps and guides
- Cycle and horse riding routes, including specialist parking and saddling area
- Watersports: reservoirs are leased for sailing, rowing, canoeing etc
- Fishing tickets sold to suit all anglers
- Wildlife: nature reserve
- Children activity packs
- Podcast tour-guides







#### **Anglian Water**

Works in partnership with 7 water parks/reserves & the Wildlife Trusts

#### **Introduced Water Park Byelaws:**

To make water parks safe and an enjoyable place to visit as well as protecting water supplies

In the interim, members of the public are requested to continue using these reservoir areas responsibly and to abide by all signage, which is placed there for public safety and for the protection of these valuable assets.




